Notes:

- Following the ExCom recommendation Referees and Coaches Seminar will be organized together as the coaches can be sure what the Rules are. All participating judges and referees at the course have to bring their official referee uniform and the karate-gi for practice.
- Referee: A Referee is permitted to compete in the Senior (if under 40yrs), or Veteran Individual Kata only - no team competition of any sort, no kumite.
- Please pay attention to the following regulations:
 - kata children are not divided into belt levels (only 1 level for all, like seniors, juniors and cadets)
 - kata teams are allowed to register 1 team member from the younger or older age group

Each candidate shall attach a short CV (full name, age, profession, name of federation, rank in karate and a photo).

Any suggestions for inclusion to the agenda or discussion on the congress should also be submitted to my office by email until 5th September 2021 in order to send out the final agenda to all members 3 weeks prior to the congress. The list of candidates and their CV with the final agenda will be published in the next Newsletter.

Please note that one person can run for one position only.

Things to do while in Resita

Steam Locomotive Museum

The Reșița Steam Locomotive Museum is an open-air railway museum located in the Triaj Park district of Reșița. Entry is free and there is no restriction on examining the exhibits. It claims it is the largest open-air railway museum in Europe.



Lacul Valiug – Resita Lake

The picturesque lake is about 10 km from the city center. It is an ideal

place to relax in nature.



Timișoara

You make take a day trip to the beautiful city of Timisoara, located 100 km away from Resita. There is a regular bus and train service operating between two towns.

Timișoara is a university city and industrial center in western Roma-

nia. It is often described as the most cosmopolitan city in Romania. Timișoara is known for Secessionist architecture. The central square, Piața Victoriei, is surrounded by baroque buildings and the Metropolitan Orthodox Cathedral, with its mosaic-patterned roof tiles and icon gallery. Nearby is the Habsburg-era square Piața Unirii and the Memorial Museum of the 1989 Revolution. The museum houses uniforms, documents and a film on the Ceaușescu dictatorship.



How to get to Resita

By plane – to Timisoara (100 km away from Resita)

The city is served by Romania's third-largest airport, Traian Vuia International Airport, located 10 km away from the city center. There are direct flights to 19 international destinations and 3 domestic destinations:

- **TAROM** has daily flights to Bucharest
- **Lufthansa** has daily flights to Munich
- **Wizz Air** has flights (not all daily) to Brussels Charleroi, Paris Beauvais, Dortmund, Frankfurt Hahn, Karlsruhe/Baden-Baden, Memmingen (Munich West), Rome Ciampino, Bergamo, Bologna, Venice Marco Polo, Venice Treviso, Bari, London Luton, Madrid, Barcelona and Valencia
- **Ryan Air** has flights to Bergamo and Bucharest
- **Blue Air** has domestic flights (not all daily) to Cluj Napoca and Iasi. For the summer, Blue Air operates Constanta (Black Sea).

Budapest (Hungary) is 286 km away (a 3.5 hour drive).




