Background:

First approach with martial arts is with Judo at the age of 9 under the guidance of his father Aldo Di Luigi (Master of Judo, black belt 6th Dan and international referee for Judo and Karate).

After several achievements at national level competitions (3 times silver and 3 time bronze medalist at the Judo Italian Championship) he is selected for the Junior Judo National Team and in 1975 he competes at the Junior Judo European Championship.

In 1972 while practicing Judo he also starts with Karate and begins his competitor career by achieving good results at national level tournaments until he wins 2 silver medals at the Karate Italian Championship and also selected for the Karate Italian National Team in 1977 and competes at the Junior European Karate Championship. In the same year he joins the athlete military team "Fiamme Gialle" of the Guardia di Finanza corp and also competes at the Senior Karate European Championship and at the WUKO World Karate Championship in Tokyo.
