Dear Mr. President,

The 1<sup>st</sup> International Open WKC Cup for Juniors, Cadets and Children in Subotica, Serbia on 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup> November was successfully organised by the Serbian Karate Union and the local Karate Club Enpi with Milorad Copić. Due to an unforeseen swine flu outbreak, the Serbian Government closed all schools for one week. Because of this, many parents were afraid to send their children to the competition. Despite this problem, over 500 competitors and eight countries attended the tournament. Last year there were more than 1.500 competitors.

Mr. Terry Boyle, Northern Ireland, also conducted an international referee course and one judge was promoted to referee and one referee to senior referee. We are looking forward to the next great WKC tournament in June 2010 when we will have the *Open European Championships* in Belgrade and the *Junior & Cadet World Championships and World Cup for Children* in Caorle, Italy, in October 2010. Hopefully at this time there will be no further epidemics

At the Executive Meeting in Subotica, we discussed various topics to move forward with which we will give you the details in our next bulletin.
