International Open WKC Championships 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> January 2014 Feldkirchen-Westerham (25 km south of **Munich**)

The preparations for the Championships are well on the way. We would like to remind you and your federation that this tournament is open for all your members, not only for national teams. Please inform your clubs regarding this tournament. It gives all karateka an opportunity to meet other teams from around the world.

There will be a mandatory referee and coach course on 24<sup>th</sup> January 2014 from 14 hours (2 pm) to 19 hours (7 pm). All referees and coaches who want to participate at the Championships must attend the course. All clubs or federations bringing a minimum of 3 competitors must also bring a referee. If they participate with 10 or more competitors then a minimum of 2 referees must attend as well.

As there is only a limited number of hotels in Feldkirchen-Westerham we recommend that bigger teams book their accommodation in Munich and take the direct train to Feldkirchen-Westerham (35 minutes from Munich main station only). There are plenty of hotels and hostels of all standards near to the Munich main station.
