Dear Mr. President,

The 1st International Open WKC Championships have been completed successfully 24th to 27th January 2014 in Feldkirchen-Westerham near Munich, Bavaria. We appreciate the hard work of the local organising committee with Mr. Norbert Dank and his team as well as the support of the Mayor of Feldkirchen Mr. Bernhard Schweiger. The Championships were opened by the patroness of the event Ms. Ilse Aigner, Minister of Economy of the State of Bavaria. Most of the medals were taken by the AAU (USA) which had also the highest entry of all participating federations followed by the KFR (Russia).

We are now looking forward to the 9th European Championships 13th to 15th June 2014 in Cheboksary, capital of the Chuvash Republic in Russia. The nearest international airport to Cheboksary is Kasan. The organising committee will provide buses for the transport of the teams. There will be members of the Karate Federation of Russia (KFR) at the international airports of Moscow (Domodedovo, Sheremetyevo and Vnukovo) as well as at the airport in St. Petersburg in order to help arriving teams with the transfer to either Kazan or Cheboksary directly. More details will be given to you in our next bulletin as well as on our webpage.

For the first time we are opening the European Championships to include *Cadets* and *Juniors*.

Note the 9th WKC World Championships for Cadets & Juniors and the World Cup for Children in Buenos Aires, Argentina, 10th to 12th October 2014.
