The registration of all participants will take place on 22nd & 23rd of June 2017 (Thursday afternoon and Friday).

The referee and coach seminar will take place on Friday, 23rd June 2017.

The tournament itself will be on Saturday, 24th and Sunday, 25th June 2017 in the Sport Center Novi Beograd, Pariske komune 20, New Belgrade.

The local organizer has arranged a very convenient accommodation in three hotels, all walking distance to the sport hall! Full information on the program, hotels, travel tips, maps, and other info will be delivered in the Newsletter in the first days of January 2017.

On the eve of the championships the Elective Congress will take place. Please think about any item which you want to have included in the agenda and whom you might want to propose for election for any position in the Executive Committee.

All persons wishing to run for a position in the Executive Committee or as an Auditor must submit their candidature by email to my office by the 20th May 2017. Each candidate shall attach a short CV (full name, age, profession, name of federation, rank in karate and a photo). Each candidate must submit a written, signed and stamped letter of support from his federation.

Any suggestions for inclusion to the agenda or discussion on the congress should also be submitted to my office by email until 20th May 2017 in order to send out the final agenda to all members 30 days prior to the congress. I will attach the list of candidates and their CV with the final agenda.

We wish you good preparations for the forthcoming world event.
