The minimum age for the karate competition at these Games is 14 years (Cadets). The different categories in the age groups Cadets, Junior and Seniors are listed under the button "Categories" and the karate competition rules may be found under "Event Rules".

Please <u>register</u> your competitors and officials only via e-mail until the  $21^{st}$  January 2011! This is the absolute deadline. Athletes will not be allowed to register or even may take part in the Games after the deadline. The registration form is published on the webpage under the button "Calendar". There you find also the forms for accommodation and visa application.

The various hotels are listed in the information package under "Calendar". Please make sure to book your accommodation only through the Tallinn organizing committee, otherwise you have to pay an extra fee to the organiser (see the information package).

The participation fees of 35 Euro for entry per individual category will go to and be collected by the local organiser, not by the WKC.

The karate competition days will be on 26 and 27 February 2011, the referee and coach seminar (mandatory for all referees and coaches) as well as the weigh-in and personal registration will be on Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> February 2011. All karate participants have to arrive in Tallinn on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2011 the latest.

We hope to meet many of the WKC member federations with their competitors as well as many guests from other karate federations at the Games.
